

RESOLUTION No. 472.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, CANVASSING THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY, ON FRIDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF APRIL, 1937, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING UPON THE PROPOSITION OF EXPENDING THE SUM OF \$5,500.00 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A RECREATION CENTER AND PARK SITE OF NINE ACRES MORE OR LESS IN LOTS 25 and 26 IN QUARTER SECTION 137 IN SAID CITY, SAID \$ 5,500.00 TO BE PAID WITH \$2,500.00 APPROVED FOR PARK PURPOSES AT A SPECIAL ELECTION AUGUST 25, 1936, \$3,000.00 TO BE PAID FROM THE GENERAL TAX FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1937-1938.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, did at a regular meeting thereof held on the 7th day of March, 1937, by a vote of more than two-thirds of all its members, duly and regularly pass and adopt Resolution No. 471, of said City, ordering calling and providing for the holding of a special election to be held in the City of Chula Vista, on Friday, the 9th day of March, ^{April} 1937, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said City a proposition for the acquisition of nine acres, more or less, in lots 25 and 26 in quarter section 137 of Ranch de la Nacion, in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, as a recreation center and park site; and

WHEREAS, it appears that notice of said election was duly and regularly given and that said election was duly and regularly held as required by law; and that in all respects said election was held and conducted, and the votes cast thereat, received and canvassed and the returns thereof made and declared, in the time, form and manner as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, has met at the Council Chambers of said City, in the City Hall, on Monday the 12th day of April, 1937, to canvass the returns of said election;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, does resolve, find, and determine and declare as follows:

Section 1. That said special election was held and conducted in said City of Chula Vista, California, on Friday the 9th day of April, 1937, in time, form and manner as required by law;

Section 2. That the proposition submitted at said election was as follows: "Shall the City of Chula Vista expend the sum of \$5,500.00 for the acquisition of a recreation center and park site of nine acres more or less in lots 25 and 26 in quarter section 137 in said city, said \$5,500.00 to be paid with \$2,500.00 approved for park purposes at a special election August 25, 1936, \$3,000.00 to be paid from the general tax funds for the fiscal year 1937-1938?"

Section 3; That there were two consolidated election precincts for said special election; that the total number of votes cast at said election was 402; that the total number of votes cast for and against said proposition at each precinct was as follows:

That the total vote cast in favor of said proposition at said election was 282; that the total vote cast against said proposition at said election was 120.

Section 4. That the City Council of said City Does hereby find, determine and declare that more than a majority of the qualified voters voting on said proposition at said election voted in favor of said proposition.

Passed, adopted and approved this 12th day of April, 1937.
