

RESOLUTION No. 488.

ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE OILING OF CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA.

WHEREAS, by resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego, California, on the 6th day of August, 1937, said County of San Diego upon the request of the City of Chula Vista has offered to assist the City of Chula Vista in the oiling of the following named streets within the territorial limits of said City, to wit:

First Avenue from "L" Street which is the south boundary of Chula Vista, thence North to connect with the pavement at "H" Street.

"I" Street from Second Avenue West to connect with U. S. Highway No. 101 on National Avenue.

"E" Street from National Avenue West to Bay Boulevard which is a continuation of the County highway entering the City of Chula Vista from the East by way of Bonita and connects said County Highway with Bay Boulevard.

Upon the condition that the said City of Chula Vista will furnish all oil needed for the purpose of oiling said streets; and

WHEREAS, to that end said County of San Diego has agreed to use its road building machinery and equipment and to furnish the necessary labor to operate said machinery in oiling said streets above named in the event the City of Council of said City of Chula Vista shall adopt a resolution accepting such offer and shall notify the County Road Commissioner that all oil necessary for said purpose is ready for delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, that the offer of said County of San Diego as set forth in the resolution of its Board of Supervisors passed and adopted on the 6th day of August, 1937, for the oiling of the streets within the City of Chula Vista hereinbefore named, be and it is hereby accepted upon the terms set forth in said resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Street Department of said City of Chula Vista, California, be and it is hereby authorized and directed to order and provide for the delivery of sufficient oil to oil said streets hereinbefore named.
